Consumer Energy Alliance and Consumer Energy Education Foundation (CEEF) hope you'll join them for this year's festival that will host energy and STEM related exhibits, demonstrations, and interactions with industry experts with the purpose of furthering the interest of students already interested in energy, conservation, and STEM, and sparking the interest in new students that have yet to discover how much fun and how many opportunities this world holds!

Colorado is the major energy hub in the West, home to major oil & gas, solar, and wind energy companies. Additionally, the state is a research center for the energy industry, hosting not only the National Renewable Energy Lab (NREL), but also home to many of the nation's leading collegiate programs, professors, and research facilities including University of Colorado, Colorado State University, and Colorado School of Mines.

In addition to our focus on energy education, Energy Day Colorado has become a leading event to introduce and showcase additional STEM activities for Colorado students. FIRST Robotics has become a major part of the festival offering competitions and demonstrations from over 30 high school robotics teams from across the state. In 2019, the event honored Kendrick Castillo, a student who had a love for robotics, but was tragically the victim of a school shooting in Highlands Ranch. The event plans to continue honoring his legacy and his love for science through continuations of the "Kendrick Castillo Memorial Robotics Tournament" in 2022 and for years to come.



CEEF, CEA, and its event production team will be following Colorado's COVID state event guidelines.

In addition, we will be working directly with Denver's Office of Special Events to ensure all city safety protocols are in place for the event.

Research has shown that outdoor activities and events have a lower risk for COVID spread. All aspects of the event will be held outdoors.

Additional onsite health and safety elements will be implemented to ensure a clean and safe event site.

All 2022 plans have focused on guest, exhibitor, and staff safety during load-in, the event itself, and load out.

Final safety rules & regulations will be announced closer to the event to ensure they comply with the latest city & state regulations.

WHO IS KENDRICK CASTILLO?

Kendrick was a student at the STEM School Highlands Ranch High School, and a senior leader on the FIRST Robotics team 4418 STEM Impulse. In 2019, Kendrick intervened in an active shooter situation in his classroom and was shot and killed while defending and protecting his classmates and teachers. His heroic actions saved many lives, and today his friends in the FIRST Robotics community honor and remember his strength of character and dedication to service. This tournament was renamed in his honor,

to carry forward his legacy within the FIRST Robotics community and beyond.
